Assignments: The How



- Pre-class
- ◆ Gauge understanding of readings/homework
 - ◆ Give students an opportunity to pose questions for in-class time
 - ◆ Tune materials based on student input to make it more relevant



- During class (synchronous or asynchronous)
- ◆ “At your own pace” activities
 - ◆ Team breakouts or lab work
 - ◆ With pre-recorded lectures or any other content



- Post-class
- ◆ Lightweight assessment
 - ◆ Confidence/preparedness rating

Assignments: What Makes It Different



Simple and easy: use existing materials to set up quickly



Flexibility: the choice is yours on how to use it



Student perception: iClicker is about engagement



Engage and adjust based on student feedback

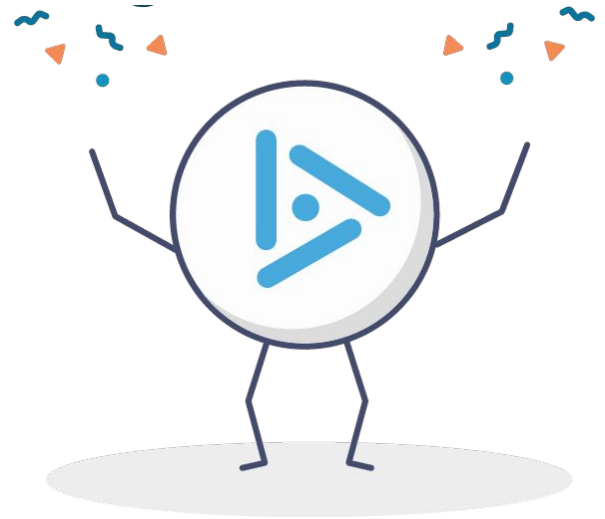
- What does the “beta” label mean?


